Chairperson welcomed Ms. Katie Haughney to Academic Council as the new PMSS representative replacing Peter Windle.

1. Minutes of Academic Council Meeting of 17 September 2024

AGREED: The minutes of the Academic Council Meeting of 17 September 2024 were approved.

2. Matters Arising

NOTED: There were no Matters Arising.

3. Policies for Approval

3.1 University Reviews Policy & 3.2 Academic Unit Review Policy.

The University Reviews Policy and Academic Unit Review Policy were circulated prior to this meeting. The University Reviews Policy sets out the requirement for the University to conduct reviews of its education provision and service delivery. It also stipulates the types of reviews to be undertaken, the objectives, stages and outcomes of reviews and the responsibilities of the University and relevant stakeholders involved in carrying out reviews.

The Academic Unit Review Policy details how the University intends to meet its statutory obligations with regard to internal quality review of its education provision.

D. O'Byrne advised members that both polices have been reviewed by the Joint Quality Committee and any feedback received to date and following this meeting and the Executive Management Team meeting will be incorporated into the final document.

Ms. Mairéad Boland joined the meeting and presented on both policies beginning with the University reviews policy which included details on the approach to the policy, review types and review model.

NOTED: Members expressed concern over the scope of the policy and felt the objectives were very programme-orientated with insufficient consideration of research and student facilities. Members also questioned where responsibility for the programmes lay as the policy seems to suggest it lay with the VP Academic Affairs rather than with the Faculty. Members also noted that the review does not consider rankings in specific subjects and asked how cross campus reviews would be supported. New faculty structures should be taken into consideration in the policy.

Ms. Mairéad Boland continued with the presentation on the Academic Unit Review Policy advising that this is the first area-specific policy to be developed and flows from the overarching University Reviews Policy. The purpose of the policy is to set out the stages and possible outcomes of the process as well as the responsibilities and expectations of specific stakeholders. The policy supports the development of a schedule of academic unit reviews and facilitates the review of individual programmes/programme suites as needed, it also supports quality enhancement as part of a cycle of continuous improvement.

NOTED: Members suggested it would be helpful to define an academic unit and to have a template for the self-evaluation report and the procedure

AGREED: The University Reviews Policy & Academic Unit Review Policy were approved in principle subject to changes discussed today and any previous feedback being incorporated into the documents which will then be brought back to the next meeting of Academic Council.

AGREED: Presentation made by Ms. M. Boland to be circulated to all members.

3.3 Policy on Providing Academic References to Students

The Policy on Providing Academic References to Students was circulated prior to this meeting. This Policy provides a framework to respond to requests for academic references and to establish acceptable practices in providing University references.

Members queried if the policy had been sent for legal review and it was suggested that advice from the University Secretary on this be sought.

Members welcomed the Policy. In response to a query it was advised that a character reference should only be included if there is demonstratable evidence available. Members also requested that the policy include guidance on completing various service providers' templates, particularly in areas such as social care. Members requested that a standard University template be made available.

It was noted that the Policy, once approved, will be communicated to staff and were advised this would be done through all staff e-mail, various webinars and through the Heads of Faculty, as well as being published on the SETU website.

AGREED: The Policy on Providing Academic References to Students was approved by Academic Council subject to the comments/feedback received today being incorporated into the policy and legal review if necessary. The Policy will be recommended to next meeting of the Policies Committee of Governing Body.

4. Committee Reports

4.1 Research & Research Programmes Committee

The Minutes of the Research & Research Programmes Committee meeting of the 1 October 2024 were circulated prior to this meeting.

NOTED: One of the roles of the Taught Studies Programmes, Teaching and Learning Committee is to develop a Teaching, Learning and Assessment Strategy. This will be a crossuniversity working group and an open invitation to join this working group will issue from the Chairperson of the committee. Terms of Reference for this group are to be drafted and it is anticipated that work will commence shortly after the reading week in October/November 2024.

4.3 Student Experience Committee

The Minutes of the Student Experience Committee meeting of the 1 October 2024 were circulated prior to this meeting.

NOTED: Mr. David Denieffe advised members that the Working Groups continue to work on the SETU Student Survey 2024/25. A draft will be available in December 2024 and the final survey will be ready in February 2025 which is similar to the timing of the National Student Survey.

4.4 Joint Quality Committee

The Minutes of the Joint Quality Committee meeting of the 1 October 2024 were circulated prior to this meeting.

Academic Council noted the Joint Quality Committees work plan 2024-25 and recommended that a five- year work plan would be beneficial, particularly in relation to the scheduling of Reviews.

5. Ratification of Examination Results

A list of programmes approved at autumn exam board meetings across the University was presented to Academic Council for ratification.

AGREED: Academic Council note and approve exam results determined at examination boards for the Departments and programmes listed in appendix A.

6. CINNTE Review Outcomes

Dr. Paul O'Leary joined the meeting and gave a brief summary of the CINNTE Institutional Review which took place from the 6 – 11 October 2024. Dr. O'Leary advised members the Panel had met with almost 200 staff during 29 meetings over the 5 days culminating in an oral report delivered by Professor Maria Hinfelaar on 11 October. It is expected that SETU will receive the draft report in 6-8 weeks and this will be considered by Academic Council.

Chairperson thanked Dr. Paul O'Leary, Ms. Mairéad Boland and all those involved for their work on the CINNTE Institutional Review.

7. CAO Update 2024/25 Entry

Dr. D. O'Byrne gave a presentation on CAO performance 2024 which included data on CAO 1st preference applications at Levels 6, 7 & 8, a summary of nett acceptances to date, CAO nett acceptances by discipline at Levels 6, 7 & 8, distribution of nett acceptances and offers at Level 8 by preference and movement in points. Dr. O'Byrne advised members that the CAO intake was very similar to last year and there was an increase in cut-off CAO points in many courses.

An overall profile of 2024/25 student intake will not be available until after the 31 October and this data will be brought to the next meeting of Academic Council.

Members noted the challenges posed when students join programmes late for various reasons and suggested a strategy be put in place for this. Members were advised that there has been an increase in EU students who tend to start later and that this, along with CAO Rounds 3-5, intensifies this issue. While 3rd October is the last date for CAO entry, consideration of the point at which a late start is detriment to the student is required. Programme marketing and the visibility of some programmes on the website was discussed and it was agreed this needs to be feed into the marketing/recruitment strategy.

A member also voiced their concern over the TRY events and the cost associated with same, it was agreed this needs to be reviewed as it may act as a deterrent to some prospective applicants.

The issue of holding interviews online for international applicants was also discussed and members were advised that this was being looked into for next year. A query on why International applicants cannot be offered places in CAO Round 0 for non-capped programmes

was also raised and M. Mullan undertook to raise this at the next CAO Operations meeting due to be held in November 2024.

D. O'Byrne advised members that conversations are ongoing in relation to returning the CAO offer date in line with pre-covid times.

8. Update on Generative AI Steering Group – Terms of Reference

Dr. Hazel Farrell gave a presentation which included the updated Terms of Reference for a GenAl Steering Group, revised composition of the Steering Committee and a list of thematic areas for 2024-2025 including framework development, communication, training and course development and a workplan for 2024-2025. It was noted that specific Working Groups may be established under the auspices of the Generative Al Steering Group.

AGREED: Academic Council approved the establishment of a GenAI Steering Group and the associated terms of reference and membership.

9. Workplan for Academic Council 2024/25

Dr. O'Byrne to liaise with the Chairpersons of each Committee to develop a detailed work plan to include timelines for data flow for Academic Council. This work plan to be brought to the next meeting of Academic Council.

10. Graduation 2024

Dr. O'Byrne advised members that graduation ceremonies are scheduled to take place from 29 October – 1 November for the Carlow and Waterford campuses and on the 8 November for the Wexford campus. Five Honorary Doctorates will be awarded during these ceremonies. Dr. O'Byrne extended an invitation to all to attend the ceremonies.

11. Career Focused Points Scheme Pilot

Document *Career-Focused Additional Points Scheme* was circulated to all members. This is a new initiative that aims to enhance student choices and retention by rewarding students for making evidence-based CAO choices aligned with their interests and aptitudes.

Mr. Michael Mullan joined the meeting firstly advising members that a pilot scheme would run in the Faculty of Business for 2024/25 entry. Mr. Mullan then gave a presentation on the scheme which included an introduction to the Career Focused Points Scheme, current challenges in course selection, impact of course preferences on student outcomes, an analysis of CAO applications and changes, the impacts of wrong course selection on progression and an overview of the pilot scheme operations and application process.

NOTED: A member queried if the Working Group were aware that this document was coming before Academic Council today, Dr. D. O'Byrne advised members that this pilot scheme had been previously signed off on by the Working Group and had been submitted to the Executive Management Team (EMT) and now to Academic Council.

NOTED: Members raised a number of queries including the process for evaluating submissions; the potential additional resources/supports that may be required; the importance of the evidence-base for informing any ongoing development of the scheme; the requirement for data to track student progress

AGREED: Report from the pilot scheme to be brought to Academic Council before any decision is made to roll this initiative out further across the University.

12. Expanding University Franchise for Seanad Elections

Dr. O'Byrne gave a brief presentation advising members that all graduates of SETU and legacy institutions who hold a degree will be eligible to vote in Seanad elections. SETU must validate entries to the initial register and must annually validate updates. New process must be in place by 31 May 2025.
