1.	Internship Title	036201 Intern – Sports Rehabilitation & Athletic Therapy
2.	Duration	6 months
3.	Working Week	The appointee will work 35 hours per week together with such additional hours as may be required from time to time for the proper discharge of their duties
4.	Department	Health Science
5.	Reports To	Head of Department or appointed nominee
6.	Duties and Responsibilities	This internship provides an opportunity for a Sport Rehab graduate to gain valuable experience bridging the gap between study and work. They will be in a position to develop their skills and knowledge base in a workplace setting under the full support and guidance of a mentor. In addition, the intern will be able to apply their knowledge in a real work environment, gain networking opportunities and build their confidence, thus enhancing their career prospects.
		The range of duties assigned to an intern may vary greatly, but the following indicate some of the principal supervised duties and responsibilities:
		<ul> <li>Prescription of rehabilitation programmes, home exercise programmes and injury prevention programmes</li> <li>Co-ordinate supervised prehabilitation/rehabilitation facilities</li> <li>Communication with the Institute nurse and doctor for referral of patients for x-rays, MRI, surgery etc</li> <li>Liaise with Sport Science intern regarding the implementation of the Institute Progressive Rehabilitation Performance (PRP) programme</li> <li>Clinic Administration: using the intranet booking system, managing overflow, dealing with clinic accounts, stock management, and preparation of clinic space before and tidying of clinic space after clinic</li> <li>Patient Caseload: it is envisaged that the intern will have his/her own patients for assessment, treatment and rehab. They will mostly come from clinic overflow, or from the sports team to which they are assigned</li> <li>Team Training &amp; Match Cover: The intern will be assigned to a sports team of the college. He/she will have duties of care for team events, preparation of athletes and management of injuries in consultation with team directors</li> <li>Undertake other duties as required by the Head of Department or other designated officer of SETU</li> </ul>

Essential Requirements	<ul> <li>A relevant SETU Level 8 Honours Degree (first or second-class) or relevant SETU Level 9 Masters degree from 2023 or 2024 OR</li> <li>A final year SETU student in the 2024/25 academic year</li> <li>Hold Professional Liability Insurance</li> <li>Be available to work some evenings and weekends</li> </ul>
