In addition, the intern will be able to apply their knowledge in a real work environment, gain networking opportunities and build their confidence, thus enhancing their sport science career prospects.

		 Liaise with Sport Rehabilitation and Athletic Therapy intern regarding the implementation of the Progressive Rehabilitation Performance (PRP) programme Develop an understanding of research practices through assisting with current undergraduate and post-graduate research projects Develop a Sport Science Support Programme for college athletes, liaising with the Barrow Centre and college sports teams to identify needs and requirements Implement and manage the Sport Science Support Programme, offering laboratory and field-based testing, data analysis and reports Maintain equipment used through the Sport Science Support Programme Provide Sport Science and Strength & Conditioning evidence-based best practice to SETU coaching personnel Maintain working environment (laboratory or field setting) to ensure effective work practice Be involved in the development of best work practice techniques Undertake other duties as required by the Head of Department/Function or other
