Module Aim	This module prepares students to engage in scholarly activity in Education at Masters level. It promotes the development of skills, knowledge and dispositions needed for effective membership of the postgraduate academic community. This module emphasises (i) the acquisition of reliable knowledge; (ii) critical engagement with ideas; (iii) effectively scholarly writing; and (iv) academic integrity.

Write in accordance with accepted academic styles and referencing conventions, suitable for Masters level study. Develop a strong and nuanced personal philosophy of academic integrity through self-reflection and understanding of current best practice.
