Module Aim	This module provides students with a theoretical and practical insight into the different styles of educational leadership and the implications for the design and development of progressive learning environments. Students will learn about the importance of a clearly communicated and collectively shared vision and mission for the development and success of their school/educational institution. Students will reflect on their own leadership philosophy and practice and learn to create effective and collaborative teams within their own educational setting.

Reflect upon & develop the means of using critical reflection to enhance practice as an educational leader. Describe and evaluate the practice of effective teamwork and collaborative practice and review the associated theory. Define and critique both Vision and Values and their impact upon the educational organisation. Identify and reflect on different conflict management styles and develop appropriate strategies to effectively manage workplace conflict.
