Module Aim	This module supports students to develop practical and actionable approaches for addressing sustainability in educational contexts. It provides a background to current and emerging understanding of sustainability, and existing policies and initiatives concerning sustainability in the education sector. It equips students with the skills to develop and implement sustainability policies and actions at school, institutional and/or community level, and to connect these local actions with the global movement for sustainability. It also facilitates students to develop a confident and nuanced approach to addressing the complexities of sustainability.
