

Financial Management & Governance in Education

(10 Credits, Level 9)

Module Aim	This module equips students with the requisite knowledge and understanding to plan for and manage finance and resources effectively in an educational context. It introduces students to key concepts of financial management within an educational setting and gives them an introduction to the parameters of modern governance in the context of a school or educational institution.
Module Learning Outcomes	 Upon successful completion of this module, a student will be able to: Demonstrate a systematic understanding of the framework of financial management within educational institutions. Evaluate critically the ethical issues involved in managing large financial resources at the disposal of educational establishments. Demonstrate a range of the skills and techniques required in relation to financial management of educational institutions. Develop a system of controls that are to be implemented in an educational environment that support good financial management practice. Facilitate standard reporting systems within educational non-profit organisations. Critique current financial management practice and governance in education in relation to international best practice. Adopt and adapt governance routines and mechanisms that are contextually fir for purpose.
