Critically reflect on their learning and practice, using a spectrum of theoretical models and effectively articulate these reflections in an integrative and scholarly manner. Critically self-evaluate in relation to practice, and create plans as well as respond effectively to emerging ideas and experiences for their continuing academic and professional development.
