

Previous Higher Education Scheme Enhancement of Leaving Certificate Points (Additional Points)

CAO applicants who have completed the Leaving Certificate, subsequently attended an Irish Higher Education Institution, and selected no. 7 Third-Level Higher Education in the "Qualifications and Assessment Summary" on their CAO application will be considered for additional points under the SETU Previous Higher Education Scheme.

Assessment is based on evidence of successfully completing a full major award, or a part thereof (minimum one year, or one semester for current SETU students). Supporting evidence must be submitted to the CAO no later than May 1st 2025. For current year Higher Education students awaiting results, evidence must be submitted no later than 30th June 2025. Applicants must meet the Leaving Certificate eligibility criteria in order to have additional points awarded.

The following are the number of Semesters you must have passed at an Irish HEI in order to qualify under this scheme:

Higher Certificate	4 semesters
Bachelors Degree	6 semesters
Honours Bachelors Degree	6-10 semesters (depending on programme)

Assessment will only be undertaken where documentary evidence of Irish Higher Education Awards (Level 6, 7 or 8) is provided.

Enhancement Points (Bonus Points)

Enhancement Points (Bonus Points) range as follows:

Qualification	Award
Higher Certificate (Level 6)	090
Degree (Level 7)	150
Degree + – Honours (Level 8)	200

Only the highest level of qualification obtained by an applicant will be taken into consideration for points.

NOTE 1: Applicants for Nursing

Applicants for SE915, SE914 and SE916 are excluded from this policy.

NOTE 2: Evidence submitted to CAO

If your evidence is in a different name, either by marriage or deed poll, then a certified copy of your marriage certificate or deed poll must also be submitted.
