Aims: The aim of this PhD research project is to explore and illuminate the distinct features of successful enterprise in the Gaeltacht na nDéise region. It intends to show how the Gaeltacht na nDéise business sector can effectively grow and provide employment in the region, utilizing digital technologies, while simultaneously supporting the distinct cultural identity of the region and its language.
